All classes will be departing Murrays Bay School Waipapa by bus at 6p.m on their day and returning at approximately 9:15am the next day. The students can wear suitable mufti clothing when arriving at Waipapa. They will wear mufti the following day at school when they return.

The students will need to have their lunch dropped off at school for their return the next day. The classroom will be open in the morning and parents are asked to place lunch on their child's desk. Lunch orders are available online.

**NB: Students need to be dropped off at the back of Waipapa NO later than 5.45pm on the day of departure.**

The cost of the camp is \$75.00 per student and includes the bus, all activities, supper and breakfast. Payments for the camp will need to be made to the school by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> of March.
