Walking School Bus

Route 1

Meet at the corner of Knight Road and Lyons Ave at 8am. Students and “Driver” walk down Lyons Ave, turning up Saddleback Rise and the onto Aotearoa Terrace. This bus enters the school from the walkway at Aotearoa Terrace.

Route 2

Meet at the corner of Penzance Road, students and “Driver” walk along Penzance Road turning onto walkway that connects Penzance and Hythe Terrace. Along Hythe Terrace to Beach Road and then along Beach Road until Sunrise Avenue. Turning into Clematis and using the Kea Crossing and entering the school from the main driveway.

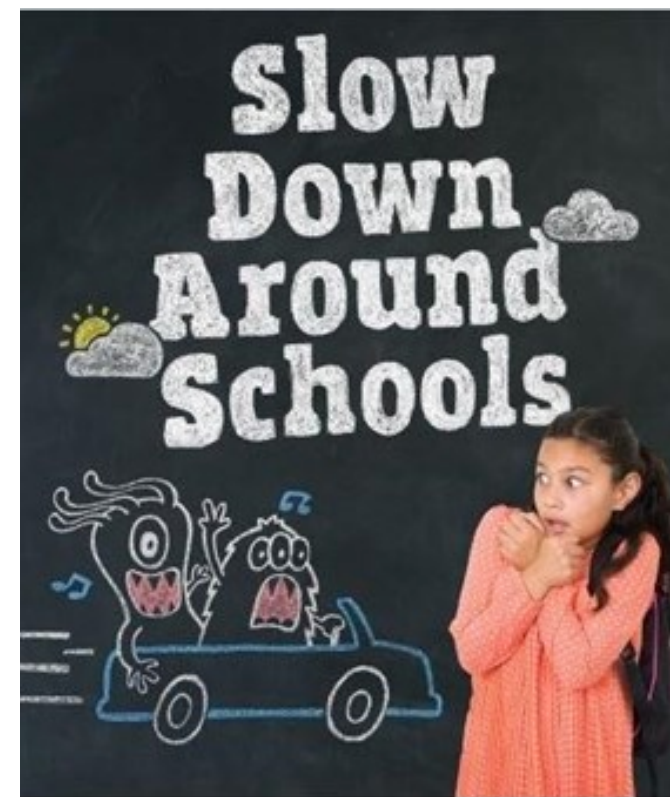

Please don't....

- Park in front of or closer than 1m to a vehicle entrance (driveway).
- Park or drop off within 6m of a pedestrian crossing.
- Park in the drop off and pick up zones (8am - 9am and 2.30pm - 3.30pm).
- Park on the footpath or a residents driveway.
- Turn right out of the school driveway between 8.30am - 9am and 2.45pm - 3.30pm.
- Make exceptions to the rules when it is raining.



Please remember to...

- Let children out on the footpath side of the car.
- Always use the Kea Crossings when crossing the road.
- Use the allocated 'Stop and Go' areas.
- Always be respectful of other road users.
- Use alternative options to arrive and leave school. Such as the Walking School Bus, bikes or scooters (age appropriate).
- Respect and obey the NZ road laws at all times.
