Last week, I had the opportunity to travel to Melbourne with our Across School Kahui Ako Literacy Leader, Mrs Lauren Hare, and Deputy Principal, Mrs Alice Andel. We spent four days engaged in professional learning and school visits with Liz Kane Literacy, our long-term partner in implementing structured literacy at our school.

We explored how principles from the science of learning can extend beyond literacy to strengthen teaching across the curriculum. Visiting several schools and connecting with education leaders reaffirmed that we're on the right path. A highlight was an evening session with Dr. Nathaniel Swain, a key voice in evidence-based education.

We're proud of our team's commitment to embedding explicit, research-informed instruction in every classroom. As we reflect and plan next steps, we look forward to sharing what we've learned with our staff and community.

The term promises, as always, to be eventful with many events planned which include school cross country, our annual Matariki Festival, Year 4 Kelly Tarlton's sleepover, book week and much more.

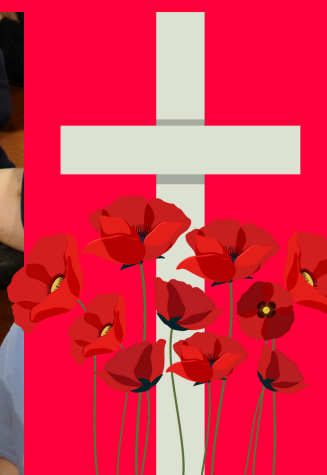

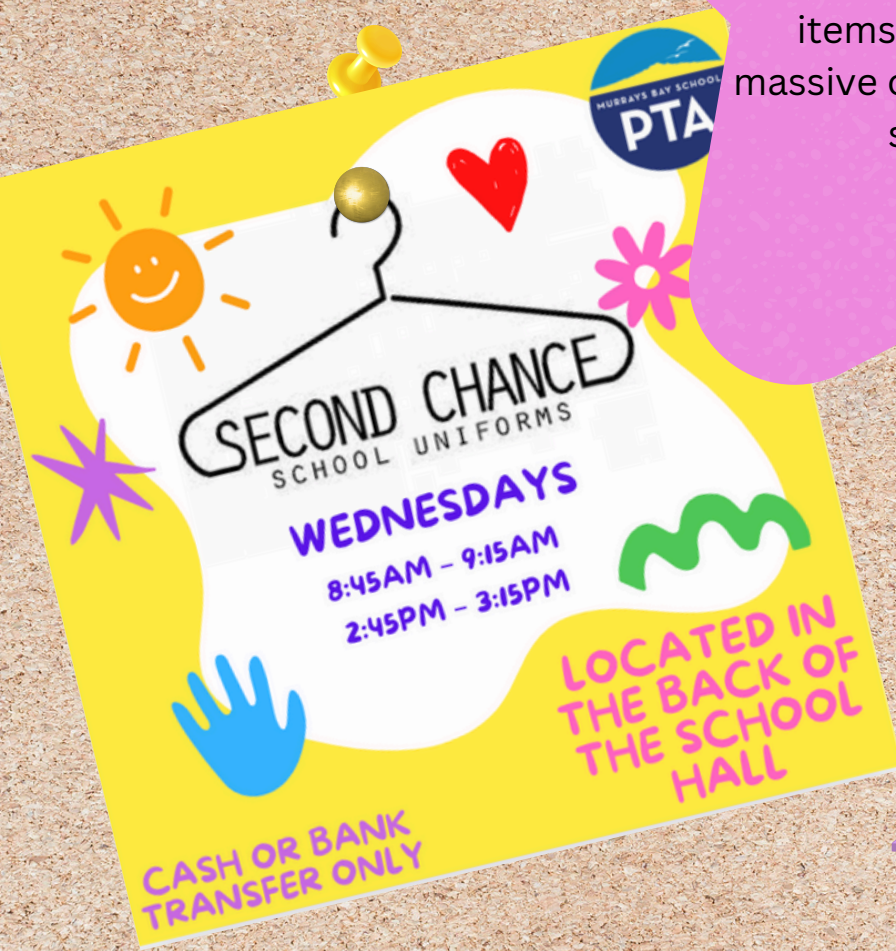
